How to connect the keyboard with multiple devices

Wired Connection

Product Features

Backlight

Connect the keyboard to computer with USB cable.

The computer will recognize and configure the keyboard automatically.



1. Press [FN]+[INS] to cyclic switch the default 8 backlight patterns.

2. Press [FN] + $[\leftarrow/\rightarrow]$ to adjust light rotating speed, total 5 levels. Press [FN] + [\uparrow / \downarrow] to adjust backlight brightness, total 5 levels.

 $3. \ Backlight \ color \ switching \ (available \ on \ limited \ light \ patterns): \ Press \ [FN]+[ENTER] \ to$ cycling switch Red, Green, Blue, Yellow, Purple, Cyan, White, RGB.

4. Backlight DIY: press [FN]+[BACK SPACE] to enter DIY mode, the keyboard backlight turn off. and LED indicator are flashing, press [FN]+[1~6] to set backlight color, once backlight settings are finishing, press [FN]+[BACK SPACE] to save.

Macro record

When the keyboard is not on macro mode or macro setting not settled, [G1~G4] keys value is [F1~F4] by default.

1. Press [Rec] button to start macro recording, LED indicator will flash slowly.

2 Press [G1~G4] to select a profile to record macro. LED indicator will flash quickly. Press the key you want to record into macro, K525RGB supporting max 64 keys macro recording.

3. After finishing macro key recording, press [Rec] to save the macro. If no operation over

30s during macro recording, the keyboard will save current marcro setting and quit recording automatically.

To output the macro, Press [G1~G4] to output the macro.

Delete recorded macro setting:

Delete all macro setting: Press& hold [EN]+ [Rec] for 5s, LED indicator flash 1 time, all macro setting was deleted.

Delete partial macro setting: Press [Rec], LED indicator flash slowly, press the [G] key you want to delete macro, LED indicator flash quickly, Press [Rec] again, the macro setting was

[WIN] lock

Press [FN] + [WIN] to lock [WIN] key, repeat to unlock.

Press [FN] + [W] to swap the functions of the [W,S,A,D] with the $[\uparrow, \downarrow, \leftarrow, \rightarrow]$ keys, repeat to recovery

Restore factory settings


Press and hold [FN] + [ESC] for 3 seconds.

- 2. If you spill liquid on the keyboard, please unplug the keyboards USB cable from the computer immediately. Wipe off excessliquid and put the keyboard in a dry and ventilated place. Make sure the keyboard is dried naturally before the next use.

Connect the mouse to computer with USB cable. The computer will recognize and configure the mouse automatically.

DPI adjustment and indication

Default DPI indicator color (scroll wheel LED breathing lighting)

- 1. RED --- 800 DPI
- 2. BLUE --- 1200 DPI
- 3. GREEN -- 1600 DPI 4. PURPLE --- 2400 DPI
- 5. YELLOW --- 10000 DPI

Report rate adjustment.

The mouse support adjust report rate[125Hz-250Hz-500Hz-1000Hz], use mouse software to set the report rate.

Backlight effect switching

Press the backlight button (on the bottom side of mouse) to cycling switch 8 default backlight effects.

For more adjustable function & macro recording, please download& install mouse software to enable more possibility.

- 1. If the mouse is not responding, please check whether the mouse is plugged correctly in the corresponding computers USB port, or try another USB ports.
- 2. If the mouse is moving slowly, jumping or with delay, please try another surface. Dark, dirty, un-flat, bright surfaces may affect the performance of mouse. Mouse pad strongly recommended.
